

# The Hahn EEZY WHEEL LIFT

At last... An effortless, and simple way of lifting the wheel and positioning it onto the wheel studs.

The **Hahn EEZY Lift** does this part of a potentially back breaking job for you and at the same time gives you two free hands to position the wheel onto the studs and do up the wheel nuts.

## STEPS IN OPERATION:

Follow all normal safety precautions

1. Stop the car, turn off the ignition, activate the hand brake.
2. Chock under the front or rear wheels as deemed necessary.
3. Loosen the wheel nuts using the wheel brace.

**NOTE: Do not remove the wheel nuts at this stage.**

4. Position the jack as indicated in your car manual.  
Activate the jack until the damaged wheel is able to spin freely and just clear of the ground.

5. Remove the wheel nuts. Pull the wheel lightly outwards and lower to the ground. Roll the wheel to a suitable safe position.

6. Clear the area beneath the wheel hub of stones, sticks or any object that could puncture the air bag.

A car floor mat can be used as an extra precaution.

7. Place the air bag in position below the hub and roll the spare wheel onto the bag with the wheel holes in line with the wheel studs. Top stud to top hole is best. *Picture 1*

**WARNING : DO NOT OVER INFLATE**

8. Remove the tyre valve cap. Attach the 'clamp on valve' to the tyre valve.

**9. Slowly press down on the tap** until the **EEZY Lift** begins to inflate, lifting the wheel.

Once the wheel is at the correct height, i.e. top wheel hole aligned with the top stud. **Release the tap.** This will shut off the air and stop the lifting action.

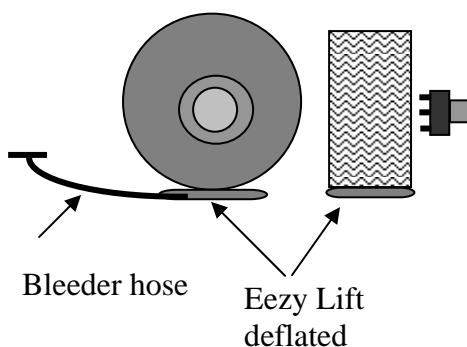

10. Detach the 'clamp on the valve'. Slowly deflate the **EEZY Lift** by **pressing down on the tap**. This will allow you to push the wheel fully onto the studs. Screw on the wheel studs finger tight.

11. Lower the jack and fully tighten the wheel nuts with the wheel brace. Replace all the equipment back into the vehicle.

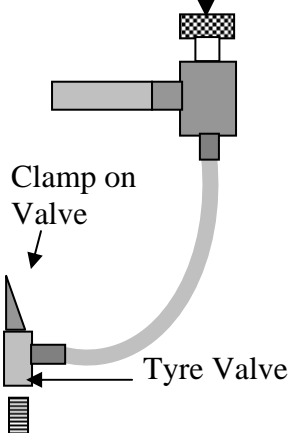

Front View Side View



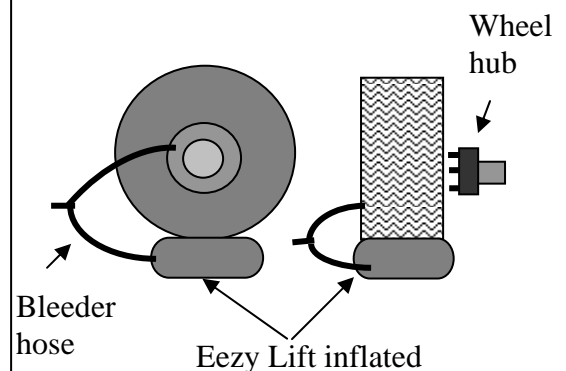
